Every day in the U.S., more than 1,000 people are injured in crashes reported to have involved a distracted driver.⁵ As an industry leader in safety, Subaru developed the DriverFocus Distraction Mitigation System,⁶ one of the first technologies of its kind. Engineered for both new and experienced drivers, it works together with EyeSight to help detect distracted or drowsy driving. If the driver's attention strays from the road for too long, DriverFocus can deliver visual and auditory alerts to bring attention back to the road.



Blind-Spot Monitor

Using radar sensors, Blind-Spot Monitor⁴ warns you with a visual indicator on your exterior mirror if it senses a vehicle in your blind spot. This system also alerts you with a flashing indicator on your exterior mirror if it senses a vehicle approaching at a higher speed in a neighboring lane and you signal for a lane change.



Front and Rear Cross-Traffic Alert

The Front and Rear Cross-Traffic Alert⁴ systems use radar sensors to help warn you of traffic approaching from the side. When backing up, alerts include an audible warning and flashing visual indicators on your exterior mirror and camera display. When driving forward, alerts include an audible warning and visual indicators on your gauge display.



Parking Support Brake

Parking Support Brake² can detect objects directly behind your vehicle when backing up at a low speed and can help bring the Solterra to a stop if it detects an object within its range and the brakes have yet to be applied.
